USE EDITING SOFTWARE to shape video clips and still photos into finished videos.

SHARE VIDEOS through our YouTube and other classes, video contests, Short Film Showcase, broadcasting on Village Television, creation of DVDs, and more.

CAPTURE OLD MEDIA, such as 35mm slides and VHS tapes, to preserve precious memories in modern digital formats.

From attending entry-level classes and informative monthly programs to joining Video One Productions and shooting a TV show -- from converting old media such as 35mm slides and VHS tapes to borrowing a camcorder to analyze your golf swing -- the Video Club is all about helping you make and enjoy videos. We shoot video with camcorders, smartphones and tablets, and DSLR and point-and-shoot cameras. We edit video on PCs and Macs, as well as on smartphones and tablets. In the **Video Lab**, we offer classes, programs, and services. In the **Video Studio**, we show you how to plan and shoot advanced projects. And if your special interest isn't already covered, you can start your own special interest Forum.

LOCATION, FACILITIES, HOURS

The Video Club is located off Moulton Parkway inside Gate 12 between Clubhouse 2 and the pool in Laguna Woods Village, Laguna Woods, CA 92637.

THE VIDEO LAB is open without charge Tue.-Fri., 1-4 pm. Supervisors are on duty to assist all residents as well as non-resident members with video-related projects.

The Lab is equipped with 13 work stations (10 PCs, 3 Macs) equipped with video production software, a large-screen smart TV, projection screen/projector, CD/DVD copier and label printers, and work tables. The Lab is used for classes, meetings, and video-related computer work. It can be set up to seat about 60 people.

Also located in the Video Lab are the **Club Office**, the **Marvin Green Capture Center** for converting old media, and our **consumer camcorder loan program**. Camcorders are checked out and in on

Wednesdays and Thursdays only.

THE VIDEO STUDIO AND CONTROL ROOM/CLASSROOM are open by appointment for work on advanced video projects as well as for meetings and classes and may be scheduled for video shoots (see other side). Studio equipment includes prosumer camcorders, audio and lighting gear, teleprompter, two shooting sets (one with green screen), and a meeting area with work table. The Video Studio can be set up to seat about 30. Our multi-camera video switcher operates from the adjoining Control Room. Room/Classroom.

MEETINGS, ACTIVITIES, EVENTS

LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

Classes are held in the Video Lab and Studio covering various aspects of video production. We teach video editing for the PC, using Corel VideoStudio. Instruction for Macintosh and iPhone/iPad users is offered in iMovie and Apple Clips.

Other classes include "Making Amazing Videos on Your Smartphone," "Intro to Video Production," "Multi-Camera Studio Production," "Intro to YouTube," "Smile for the Camera," and more.

Certification Program: Dr. Tom Nash, coordinates training and proficiency-testing in the use of Video Studio equipment.

Individual Coaching sessions may be scheduled in video editing, and other aspects of video production. To request individual coaching, email videocluboflagunawoods@gmail.com.

Special Interest Forums may be created for short- or long-term focus on specific equipment, software, or video projects.
