NEW CLASS: "Four Easy Steps to Make A 4-Minute Video Story About Your Life," 5 sessions. Instructors: Sheryl Martin, Jonathan Williams. In days gone by, people sat around the fire telling stories. Now they watch videos – so learn how to tell your story in video! It's easy and fun. In this hands-on class, students will produce a 4-minute "video story of your life" (or of someone else's), using still photos (and video clips when available). Some work will be done in class under supervision; some homework will be included. The final class session will be devoted to viewing and discussing student projects.

This class will NOT teach video editing, but students new to editing will be introduced to Canva, a very simple, free, online video-editing program. Topics covered will include digitizing and organizing photos; eliciting memories for story development; transferring photos to a computer from cell phones and cameras; an overview of video editing programs; how to add narration, music, and more to your video; and working with online (and other) video resources.

It's very do-able with VideoStudio, the powerful and relatively easy-to-use video editing software taught by the Video Club. Spend three Saturday mornings and learn video editing! In this class, we'll cover the basics to get you started.
