


Born Thomas Lewellen Nash on July 3, 1936 in Randolph, Vermont, Tom grew up with a fascination for microphones, radios, and all the latest technology of the era. As a child, he embraced a deep Christian faith that informed his life.

Tom served as a missionary in Osaka, Japan, and afterwards earned a doctorate from Michigan State. After working in broadcast, Dr Nash went on to create a very successful radio, television and film program at Biola University.

Tom and his wife Darlene moved to Laguna Woods in 2013. After Darlene's passing in 2014, Tom built a new community for himself in the Village, including a large circle of friends made through dance and the Video Club. His kindness, generosity, and humility have left a mark on many.

Tom was predeceased by Darlene, and by his son Robert. He leaves a daughter Suzanne, her husband Dale, Darlene's daughters: Tracy Homer, Cindy Western, and Kathy Dawes, and two grandchildren: Scott and Meredith Rice.
